Kevin O. Thompson was appointed to The University of Akron Board of Trustees in 2007. He chairs the Collective Bargaining and Strategic Issues, Governance, and Compliance committees and serves on the Educational Policy/Student Affairs; External Affairs; Facilities Planning and Oversight; Finance, Fiscal Policy, and Investment; Nominating; and Rules committees.
